




Skills and Functions Associated with the Lobes of the Brain

Frontal Lobe Controls

- Attention
- Motivation
- Emotional, social, sexual control
- Verbal expression
- Judgement
- Spontaneity
- Problem solving
- Decision making
- Expressive language
- Motor integration
- Voluntary movement
- Sequencing



Temporal Lobe Controls

- Short-term memory
- Receptive language
- Language comprehension
- Musical awareness
- Selective attention
- Object categorization
- Locating objects
- Face recognition
- Behavior (aggressive)

Parietal Lobe Controls

- Tactile perception (touch)
- Spatial orientation
- Awareness of body parts
- Academic skills
- Object naming
- Right/left organization
- Visual attention
- Eye-hand coordination

Occipital Lobe Controls

- Visual perception
- Visual processing
- Reading (the perception and recognition of printed words)

Cerebellum Controls

- Coordination of voluntary movement
- Gross and fine motor coordination
- Postural control
- Balance and equilibrium
- Eye movement

Brain Stem Controls

- Autonomic nervous system (heart rate, breathing, temperature, etc.)
- Level of alertness
- Arousal and sleep regulation
- Swallowing food and fluid
- Balance and movement
